In both A & B games, play shall consist of 4 x 15 minute quarters. There will be a three minute break at the end of the first quarter and the third quarter with five minute break at half time.

The electronic score board will be stopped before the end of each quarter to allow the umpire's whistle to dictate the end of play.

In the event of a draw after full-time there will be a two-minute stoppage.

Extra time shall consist of 2 x 7 minute halves with an interval of one minute at half time. In the event of a tie at the end of extra time, a visual signal shall be used to indicate that play shall continue until one team has a two-goal advantage.
