The electronic score board will be stopped before the end of each quarter to allow the umpire's whistle to dictate the end of play.

In the event of a draw after full time there will be a 2 minute stoppage. Extra time shall consist of 2 x 7 minute halves with an interval of 1 minute at half time. In the event of a tie at the end of extra time, a visual signal shall be used to indicate that play shall continue until one team has a 2 goal advantage.
