History of Senior Inter-County

A brief history of the Senior Inter-county Netball fixture

The Orkney Netball Association was founded on the 11th January 1981. A friendly game was arranged between Orkney and Shetland played before the actual inter-county which took place in Shetland on Friday 13th November 1981. With six teams were entered into a winter league from where the first A & B teams were selected. The Orkney winter league is still going strong to this day. From small beginning a fantastic netball community began.

How times have changed....

When the first netball inter-county games took place teams hosted each other, these days teams stay together.

Teams would travel on the Friday and play that evening traveling home on the Saturday, unless fog was present.

In 1981 the air fare called a 'firecracker' was £37 return.

Some Interesting Facts

- Most Goals scored in one match 69. Orkney A team scored 69 goals against Shetland in 1991.
- Both teams have scored upwards of 60 goals in a match, Orkney A team as above in 1991 and Shetland A team in 2008 when they scored 68. Orkney B Team have scored upwards of 60 goals twice, with 62 goals in 1988 ad 65 goals in 1990.
- Following this year's fixture the matches will have been played equally 20 times on both islands.
- There has only ever been one draw, in the B match of 1996 when the teams drew 30 30.
- For the first six years of the fixture, the A team lost at home!
- There has been no B match played on four separate occasions, although a friendly against Whalsay was played in 1999 instead.
- Orkney have won the A match 25 times with Shetland winning 13 of the contests.
- Orkney have won the B match 19 times, with Shetland winning 16. Shetland has won both fixtures in the same year on seven occasions whilst Orkney have won both fixtures on 13 of the meetings.
